

## Faith Facts from the Bible

- Doubt & Unbelief are the opposite of Faith
- Faith can be seen
- We receive according to our faith
- Cowardly have no faith
- You can ask to have your faith increased, the Apostles did
- We have faith
- Pray your faith and others faith will not fail, Jesus did this for Peter
- You can turn back if you did fail, Jesus told Peter to strengthen others when he would turn back
- You can be strengthened in faith
- Faith should lead to obedience
- Obedience seals faith
- Comforted by other's faith
- The Gospel is God's power for salvation and the righteous by faith will live
- Faith was credited to Abraham as righteousness and it will be for you too
- You will inherit the world through the righteousness that comes by faith
- Strengthened through the gospel of the Kingdom and the proclamation of Jesus Christ
- God is faithful (trustworthy) – He will strengthen you to the end, so that you will be blameless on the day of our Lord Jesus Christ.
- Faith is a gift
- Faith is based on the demonstration of God's spirit and of God's power, not on human wisdom
- If Jesus was not raised from the dead then your faith is futile and empty
- Same spirit of faith that us to speak (because we believe)
- We are expected to excel in faith
- As our faith grows God's work expands
- The law is not based on faith, we receive the promise of the spirit by faith (and obedience – Acts 2:38)
- Declared righteous by faith
- Sons of God through faith
- One in Christ through faith
- Heirs through faith
- Saved by grace (gift of God) through your faith (belief/trust)
- Because of Jesus' faithfulness (trust & belief) we have boldness and confident access to God
- With the shield of faith we can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one
- Firm faith comes from the Gospel you have heard
- Firm faith overflows with thankfulness
- We should strengthen and encourage others about their faith so nobody is shaken by afflictions
- We must put on the breastplate of faith and love and as a helmet our hope for salvation
- Faith flourishes in the persecutions and afflictions you are enduring
- **Salvation is through sanctification by the Spirit and faith in the truth (called to this salvation through the Gospel of the Kingdom, so that you may possess the glory of our Lord Jesus)**

- God's redemptive plan operates by faith
- People can and will desert the faith so nourish yourself on the words of faith, good teaching
- The love of money can make you stray from the faith
- Told to compete for the faith and lay hold of that eternal life you were called for
- Protect what has been entrusted to you
- Scripture gives you wisdom so have faith in Jesus and salvation
- Faith needs to be healthy – stay away from people who reject the truth
- Those who have placed their faith in God should be intent on engaging in good works, not things that are useless and empty
- Faith brings assurance and unwavering hope (Kingdom hope)
- Shrink back and perish or live by faith and receive a great reward and live
- testing of your faith produces endurance
- Those who love (and obey) God are rich in faith and heirs of the kingdom
- Faith and works go together. Faith saves
- Faith without works is dead, just as works without faith is dead
- Protected through faith by God's power, although suffering now, great joy
- Trials prove the character of your faith
- You do not see, yet you believe in and love him
- the **goal of your faith**—the salvation of your souls.
- Faith and hope are in God.
- Be strong in your faith, resist the Devil because you know that your brothers and sisters around the world are enduring the same kind of suffering
- 1 John 5:4-5 – Faith is the conquering power that has conquered the world
- Contend earnestly for the faith that has been entrusted to the saints
- Faithfulness is a fruit produced in the believer who has receive God's spirit
