Matthew 9:2 When Jesus saw their faith....

Matthew 9.22 your faith has made you well

9.29 let it be done according to your faith

*Matthew 14.31 You of little **faith**, why did you **doubt**?*

Mark 4.39-40 (Jesus calmed storm) "Why are you cowardly? Do you still not have faith?"

Luke 17:5-6 – Apostles said, "Increase our faith!"

Luke 18:8 – when the Son of Man comes, will he find faith on earth?

Luke 22:32 – Jesus prayed for you, Simon, that your faith may not fail. When you have turned back, strengthen your brothers."

Acts 3 15-16 – faith that is through Jesus

Acts 14:8-10 – Man listening to Paul, Paul saw he had faith to be healed

Acts 14:9 – he had faith

Acts 16:5 – strengthened in the faith = same pistis Acts 24:24-25 – sent to speak about faith in Messiah

Acts 26:17-18 – Jesus sent Paul to open eyes so people will turn from darkness to light, from power of Satan to power of God SO THAT THEY MAY receive forgiveness of sins and a share among those who are sanctified by faith in Jesus – discussing righteousness, self-control, and the coming judgment

Acts 27.25 – keep up your courage, I have faith in God that it will be just as I have been told.

Romans 1:5 – obedience of faith

Romans 1:11-32

(Romans 1:12) – mutually comforted by one another's faith when church uses their spiritual gifts, (Paul wanted to come and impart SG AND preach the Gospel)

(Romans 1:16-17) – Paul was not ashamed of the Gospel because it is God's POWER for SALVATION for everyone who chooses to believe and accept it. The righteousness of God is revealed in the Gospel from faith to faith, just as it is written, "The righteous by faith will live."

(Romans 1:18-21) – God's wrath coming on those who suppress the truth by their unrighteousness. WHAT CAN BE KNOWN IS PLAIN TO US! Since creation we see God's invisible attributes – eternal power and divine nature – CLEARLY SEEN! We can understand by what God has made. People are without excuse. WE ARE WITHOUT EXCUSE! PROBLEM is knowing God, but not glorifying Him or giving thanks. PROBLEM is having futile thoughts and senseless hearts.

(Romans 1:22-25) – **PROBLEM is exchanging the truth for a lie**, exchanging the immortal God's glory, the Creator's glory, for something else, something created – that HE created!

(Romans 1:28-32) – PROBLEM is not acknowledging God and this leads to a depraved and sinful mind. PROBLEM is they know God’s righteous decree that those who do such things deserve to die. PROBLEM is they not only do them, but approve of those who practice them.

Romans 4

*(Romans 4:9) “faith **was credited to Abraham as righteousness.**”*

(Romans 4:11) – And he received the sign of circumcision as a seal of the righteousness that he had by faith while he was still uncircumcised (his obedience sealed his faith)

Romans 4:13 – righteousness that comes by faith (For the promise to Abraham or to his descendants that he would inherit the world was not fulfilled through the law, but through the righteousness that comes by faith.)

(Romans 4:17-25) – Abraham is the father of our faith. He believed the God who makes dead people alive and summons the things that do not yet exist as though they already do. AGAINST HOPE Abraham believed in hope. NOT WEAK IN FAITH even though his body as good as dead. He did not waiver in unbelief about the promise of God, but was strengthened in faith, giving glory to God. He was FULLY CONVINCED what God promised He was able to do. OUR FAITH is also credited to us as righteousness, our belief in the one who raised Jesus from the dead.

Romans 5:1 – Since we have been declared righteous by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ

Romans 10:1-3 (vs. 2) For I can testify that they are zealous for God, but their zeal is not in line with the truth.

Proverbs 19:2 is dangerous to have zeal without knowledge

*Romans 16:25-26 – To him who is able to strengthen you according to my gospel and the proclamation of Jesus Christ, according to the revelation of the mystery that had been kept secret for long ages, but now is disclosed, and through the prophetic scriptures has been made known to all the nations, according to the command of the eternal God, to bring about the **obedience of faith**— to the only wise God, through Jesus Christ, be glory forever!*

1 Corinthians 1:8-9 God is faithful (trustworthy) (pistos) – He will strengthen you to the end, so that you will be blameless on the day of our Lord Jesus Christ.

1 Corinthians 2:4-5 – faith based on the demonstration of God’s spirit and of God’s power, not on human wisdom

1 Corinthians 12:4-7, 9 – (9) gift of faith

1 Corinthians 13:12-13 – For now we see in a mirror indirectly, but then we will see face to face. Now I know in part, but then I will know fully, just as I have been fully known. Faith, hope, and love

1 Corinthians 15:14, 17 – If Christ has not been raised, then our preaching is futile and your faith is empty,

1 Corinthians 16:13-14 – Stay alert, stand firm in the faith, show courage, be strong. Everything you do should be done in love.

2 Corinthians 4:13 *But since we have the same spirit of faith as that shown in what has been written, “I believed; therefore I spoke,” we also believe, therefore we also speak. (believe)*

2 Corinthians 5:7 – *We live by faith, not by sight.*

2 Corinthians 8:7 – *But as you excel in everything—in faith, in speech, in knowledge, and in all eagerness and in the love*

2 Corinthians 10:15-16 – *As faith continues to grow, work greatly expanded*

Galatians 3:11-14 – *It is clear no one is justified before God by the law, because **the righteous one will live by faith.** The law is not based on faith, we receive the promise of the spirit by faith.*

Galatian 3:23-29 – *Before faith we were held in custody under the law, being kept as prisoners until the coming faith would be revealed. Thus the law had become our guardian until Christ, so that we could be declared righteous by faith. But now that faith has come, we are no longer under a guardian. For in Christ Jesus you are all sons of God through faith. For all of you who were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ. ²⁸ There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is neither male nor female —for all of you are one in Christ Jesus. And if you belong to Christ, then you are Abraham’s descendants, heirs according to the promise.*

Galatians 5:1 *For freedom Christ has set us free. Stand firm, then, and do not be subject again to the yoke of slavery. (5:5-6) For through the Spirit, by faith, we wait expectantly for the hope of righteousness. For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision carries any weight—the only thing that matters is faith working through love. (22-23) the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. Against such things there is no law.*

Ephesians 2:8 - *By grace you are saved, **through faith**, and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God*

Ephesians 3:10-12 – *We have boldness and confident access to God by way of Christ’s faithfulness*

Ephesians 6:16 – *taking up the shield of faith with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one*

Colossians 1:5-8 – *Your faith and love have arisen from the hope laid up for you in heaven, which you have heard about in the message of truth, the gospel (which is in entire world bearing fruit and growing)*

*Colossians 1:21-23 – enemies in your minds as expressed through your evil deeds, but now he has reconciled you **if indeed you remain in the faith**, established and firm, without shifting from the hope of the gospel that you heard. This gospel has also been preached in all creation under heaven, and I, Paul, have become its servant.*

*Colossians 2:4-9, 12 – warned of deception through arguments that sound reasonable, Paul rejoiced in the firmness of their faith, live lives rooted and built up in Jesus, firm in your faith, overflowing in thankfulness. Buried with Jesus in **baptism** and raised up with him through your faith in the power of God who raised him from the dead*

1 Thessalonians 1:2 – Work of faith and labor of love and endurance of hope in our Lord Jesus Christ.

1 Thessalonians 3:2-3, 5-6 – Paul sent Timothy to strengthen and encourage you about your faith so nobody shaken by afflictions. We are destined to afflictions. Feared the tempter had tempted them and was concerned about their faith

1 Thessalonians 5:8 – must put on breastplate of faith and love and as a helmet our hope for salvation

2 Thessalonians 1:3-4 – Paul thanks God for people’s faith flourishing and for their love expressed one to another. Boast to others about their faith in all the persecutions and afflictions you are enduring

2 Thessalonians 1:11-12 – God will make you worthy of his calling and fulfill by his power your every desire for goodness and every work of faith, the name of our Lord Jesus may be glorified in you, and you in him

*2 Thessalonians 2:12-15 – All of them who have not believed the truth but have delighted in evil will be condemned. You are chosen for **salvation through sanctification by the Spirit and faith in the truth**. You are **called to this salvation through the Gospel of the Kingdom**, so that you may possess the glory of our Lord Jesus. Therefore, **STAND FIRM!***

1 Timothy 1:3-5 – God’s redemptive plan operates by faith

1 Timothy 4:1-2, 6-7 – Now the spirit explicitly says that in the later times some will desert the faith and occupy themselves with deceiving spirits and demonic teachings, influenced by the hypocrisy of liars whose consciences are seared. Nourish yourself on the words of faith, good teaching

1 Timothy 5:8 – If you don’t provide for his own (Christians?) and especially his family he has denied the faith and is worse than an unbeliever

1 Timothy 6:10-12, 20-21 – love of money can make you stray from your faith and create many pains. If dedicated to God, better to love and pursue righteousness, godliness, faithfulness, love, endurance, and gentleness. Compete for the faith and lay hold of that eternal life you were called for. Protect what has been entrusted to you. Abstain from profane chatter and absurdities of so-called “knowledge.” By professing it, some have strayed from the faith

*2 Timothy 1:12 – I am not ashamed, because **I know the one in whom my faith is set and I am convinced that he is able** to protect what has been entrusted to me until that day*

2 Timothy 3:14-17 – You should be confident about what you have learned. You have known the holy writings, which are able to give you wisdom for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus. Every Scripture is

*inspired by God and useful that the **person dedicated to God** may be capable and equipped for every good work.*

Titus 1:13-14 – be healthy in the faith, don't pay attention to myths and commands of people who reject the truth

Titus 3:8-9 – Insist on such truths, so that those who have placed their faith in God may be intent on engaging in good works, not things that are useless and empty

Philemon 1:5-6 – I pray the faith you share with us may deepen your understanding of every blessing that belongs to you in Christ.

Hebrews 10:22-23 – Let us draw near with a sincere heart in the assurance that faith brings, let us hold unwaveringly to the hope that we confess, for the one who made the promise is trustworthy

*Hebrews 10:35-39 - Do not throw away your confidence, it has great reward. You need endurance in order to do God's will and so receive what is promised. **The righteous one will live by faith, and if he shrinks back, I take no pleasure in him.** We are not among those who shrink back and thus perish, but are among those who have faith and preserve their souls*

Hebrews 11:1-3 – Now faith is being sure of what we hope for, being convinced of what we do not see. By faith we understand that the worlds were set in order at God's command, so that the visible has its origin in the invisible.

James 1:2-3 –Consider it nothing but joy when you fall into all sorts of trials, because you know that the testing of your faith produces endurance.

James 2:5 – Did not God choose the poor in the world to be rich in faith and heirs of the kingdom that he promised to those who love him?

James 2:14 - Faith and works go together. Faith saves

James 2:17-19 – Faith without works is dead, just as works without faith is dead. Believing God is one is good, but even the demons believe that and tremble with fear.

*1 Peter 1:3-9, 21 – New birth, living hope through resurrection, inheritance reserved in heaven, protected through faith by God's power, although suffering now, great joy. The trials prove the character of your faith, which is more valuable than gold. You do not see, yet you believe in and love him. You rejoice with an indescribable and glorious joy because you are attaining the **goal of your faith**—the salvation of your souls. Your faith and hope are in God.*

2 Peter 1:5-8 – make every effort to add to your faith excellence, knowledge, self-control, perseverance, godliness, brotherly affection, unselfish love, if these continually increase, they will keep you from becoming ineffective and unproductive in your pursuit of knowing Jesus more intimately.

1 Peter 5:9 – Resist the Devil and be strong in your faith because you know that your brothers and sisters around the world are enduring the same kind of suffering

1 John 5:4-5 – the conquering power that has conquered the world is our faith.

Jude 1:3 – contend earnestly for the faith that has been entrusted to the saints

Acts 14.9 he had faith and acts 16:5 strengthened in the faith = same pistis

2 Corinthians 4.13 But since we have the same spirit of faith as that shown in what has been written, “**I believed; therefore, I spoke,**” we also believe, therefore we also speak.
