1.THE IMPORTANCE OF BIBLICAL TRUTH IN OUR MINISTRY.

Why we insist on biblical truth;

- ➤ Because we believe it matters what one believes and this is our responsibility as a ministry to adhere to and help others adhere to these truths.
 - 2PETER 1:12 Wherefore I will not be negligent to put you always in remembrance of these things, though ye know *them*, and be established in the present truth.
 - (As many people become more culturally hostile and doubtful to biblical truth, many Pastors, religious leaders tend to compromise in order to get along with the majority and gather many people into their churches or buildings!
 - As a ministry we have chosen to faithfully and uncompromisingly live our lives on the basis of the revealed biblical truth.)
- ➤ Because biblical truth sets us free from religious or Babylonian opium. John 8:31-32. This conviction has led us to accept the ultimate authority of the Bible and the need to search for truth through careful Bible study under the guidance of the Holy Spirit.
- ➤ Gal 5:1 Living in these truths helps us to walk in our freedom in Christ.
- > Because these revealed truths brings us hope, lasting happiness and satisfaction.
- ➤ Because the concern for the truths helps us to prepare for the Second Coming.

Challenges of holding unto the truth.

- > We often face intense opposition.
- > Big numbers versus small numbers syndrome.
 - (We are committed as a ministry to demonstrate our moral and theological courage in the face of stiffening cultural and religious opposition.
 - The Panic to get more people into our churches will not tempt us to compromise the BASIC BIBLICAL TRUTHS.
 - In regard to biblical errors our conscience is captive to the word of God, we cannot recant. Our success will be purely defined by biblical truths.
 - Compromise is counter productive and destructive when it comes to bible doctrines.)

2. ABOUT THE HEAD QUARTERS BUILDING AND THE ACTIVITIES THERE.

The headquarters idea was necessitated by the governments policy to regulate churches and all religious organizations in the country in November 2014.

This proposed regulation required all churches to be registered with the registrar of societies and belong to an umbrella body to regulate their activities and curtail the rogue ministers who by then had been mushrooming and fleecing unsuspecting congregants and exploiting them financially, and in way provide accountability of individual churches.

Since the fellowship of believers in Kenya was growing rapidly and the brothers were scattered all over the country, it was necessary for our various groups to be organized in a way and comply with the legal requirements of the government by then.

As a result, we registered the fellowship in Kenya under the legal names of (KINGDOM LIFE ABRAHAMIC FAITH MINISTRIES) ON 25TH OF June 2015.

This provided a sense of security and assurance to the congregants that we were now a legally recognized group in the country, authorized to conduct ministry within the legal frame work.

Disclaimer; Much as we do not really take pride in being organized and having a headquarter, most of our congregants are coming from religious backgrounds that promoted this idea and so it suffice to say here that the idea provides an assurance of continuity, regulation and legitimacy of the individual congregations and peace of mind in the matters accountability.

Thus, we have adopted the idea and expanded the concept to advance the course of the gospel of the kingdom and the ministries operations.

The central place and building was facilitated with the help of **LHI** (Lords Harvest International) and other partners.

To date, the headquarter building serves as a place for:

- ➤ Public corporate worship and fellowship for the brethren Acts 2:46
- ➤ Hosts our national churches conferences for theological expositions
- > Provides accommodation for guests during the conventions
- > Serves as a training centre for the **Atlanta bible college** (**Kenyan Extension**) programmes.
- > Serves as the nerve for coordinating branch churches kingdom impact and advancement efforts
- ➤ In summary.it serves our educational, housing and ministry endeavours.

3. MY TRAVELS TO ENCOURAGE OTHER CHURCHES AND HELP LIKE MINDED BELIEVERS START LOCAL CHURCHES.

Our ministry has adopted three strategies in advancing its mandate to proclaim the gospel of the kingdom of God and to share other restored truths to help like-minded people and to reach those unreached with the pure and undiluted word of God.

> CONTACT SHARING.

Through deliberate and strategic sharing of contacts, numerous networks are established through which efforts to share the bible truths are initiated in line with our ministry's mission objectives. we employ the admonition of Jesus to his disciples **TO LOOK FOR A CONTACT WHO IS WORTHY.**

MATT 10:11

"Now whatever city or town you enter, inquire who in it is worthy, and stay there till you go out.

> Other truth inquirers from all over the world often get in touch while exploring our online platforms and others are also referred to us by those whom they get in touch with as they inquire about our ministry, follow ups are usually made in response to this inquiries and we have seen local congregations spring up out of this model.

There arises demand for more sharing of the truths once the reception towards the truths shared is good! People tend to want to know and here more.

> TRAINING AND EQQUIPING OF MINISTERS

In liaison with Atlanta Bible college (Kenyan Extension)

The ministry identifies members who show interest and present need for equipping and preparing for ministry work and offers training opportunities to them and other interested members of the

community and congregation.

Once a need arises for ministry or church expansion, these leaders are usually commissioned to oversee the congregations.

Plans are underway to fully operationalize this liaison with Atlanta bible college so as to offer opportunities for maximum utilization by the African students offering them a near or same experience AND FEELING of being in ATLANTA.

LIKE MINDED PASTORS WHO ARE ALREADY IN MINISTRY.

We also work with other pastors of other churches who are already engaged with church work, and who after encountering these truths show a willingness and request to be helped along with their congregations to arrive at a common understanding of the scriptures as far as these truths are concerned.

- The ministry hosts annual theological conferences which bring together all churches under this umbrella to celebrate these truths as a family, to meet new believers and strengthen relationships and inspire each other.
- > These conferences provide opportunity to share experiences and also to interact with other believers worldwide as we always invite our brethren's from across the nation and world during such times.
- As a result of all this there is a constant need to reach out to this congregations and leaders and groups to strengthen them and establish them in the truths as they continue to impact their communities.

This normally presents a financial need that needs to be consciously considered in our ministry budgets and support from our partners.

These new congregations often require support with construction of temporary tin structures which are used as meeting places,

Other Tent Making Activities Our Ministry Does.

- > The ministry has also established a welfare support programme to help upgrade living conditions for its most vulnerable members by helping provide basic economic boost activities that can be run by the families to improve mostly food security, we solicit and provide help with local birds for poultry rearing this provides families with eggs, meat and even some are sold to boost family incomes., dairy cows for milk production which some is sold and some utilized by the families, we also do fish and bee farming.
- ➤ We also engage in agricultural produce of both food and cash crops to boost the ministries income enable emergence response to critical needs and reduce over dependence on aid
- Among the cash crops we farm is sugar canes and corn.

Upcoming Ministry Income Project.

- Lord willing, we plan to acquire a water purifying machine which will be installed at the ministry's premises to enable us harvest, purify, bottle, brand and distribute bottle water for sale. A plan has been initiated already which will see a well drilled at the ministry's site soon.
- Lord willing also the ministry's leadership has earmarked **the transport industry** and **real estate** as Crucial investment opportunities if funds are available in the near future and if Jesus tarries to come
- ➤ We desire to build a few units on a section of the church piece of land to rent out to many college staff and students who have joined the recently launched college institution in the community thus triggering a demand for goods and services which have not been there in the past. This definitely presents us with an opportunity to offer this solution which will eventually enable the ministry to collect some monthly income.

- ➤ We also envision acquiring at least two transport vans for the ministry which apart from transporting members during mega conferences, they can be engaged in public transport to also generate income for ministry use.
- ➤ If these plans are rolled out, dependency on aid and donation will completely be a thing of the past and we can take charge of our huge financial needs and elevate the accompanying constraints and occasional slow execution of ministry plans.

GELLIAD MEDICAL HOSPITAL PROJECT.

- Additionally, we have been privileged to have two brothers in the fellowship who have offered us the opportunity to use their vast land resources for agriculture as mentioned above and one for the development of a medical facility that has been named **Gilead medical centre.** Jeremiah 8:20-22.
- ➤ With the recent global Covid plight, it will be great to develop a rescue centre where Gods people can seek true and affordable medical care for their families when need arises.
- ➤ With this 9-acre facility, we have two of our members pursuing medical studies in preparation to help with implementation and administration of the facility once it will be realized in future at Gods time.
