## **Pray for Haiti**

Pastor Lesley wrote LHI letting them know that he and the children in the orphanage were safe.

He said the earthquake was 7.06 like the last one in 2010. It struck the southern part of Haiti the hardest. The two major cities Les Cayes and Jeremie, reported at the time that that 1.497 people were killed, 6975 injured, 14.372 homes destroyed, 30.000 families homeless, and 54.225 homes were damaged.

We have three churches in the South and Pastor Lesley was there five days before

the earthquake to train church leaders. He left two days before the earthquake.

The small town where Lesley was born, St. Jean du Sud (St. John of South), was devastated and our churches located in this area were seriously struck by the earthquake.

Three children of one church family died under a collapsed house and many of our church leader's homes received serious damaged and now will have a very difficult life.

Please stand with them in prayer and consider how you can help our brethren financially.




**Afghanistan**

When the man came to the apartment, others opened the door and said, "they don't live here anymore." Needless to say, Shakhrom is shaken. He doesn't know if they are on the run, or more likely, murdered.

Please pray for his relative's safety and that if they are alive that they would be protected and able to get in touch with our brother. Also pray for peace and comfort for Shakhrom. Thank you!


makes finding and keeping a job difficult. He is a minority of the minority.




