Pray for Our Chinese Brethren



Pastor Maksim and I had the pleasure of talking to a brother and sister in Canada who helped make a flyer in Chinese years ago for Maksim to use at the Chinese markets in his city. This wonderful teamwork opened a door for a young man who was searching for truth and we ended up gaining a brother.

Our friends shared some very sobering information about Christians in China. Please pray for our brethren all around China.

It is much harder for religious groups to gather. The biggest problem is that many of these laws are now being enforced. There are bigger hardships and more crackdowns on Christians in northern China. In the south Christians are a bit more active and more "free."

Many churches are meeting on Zoom, but are still careful with what they say in case somebody on is recording. They believe that the government has not cracked down on these believers because they are probably working more on gathering information at this time. People hesitate to speak, so the fellowship online is not very intimate.

The Chinese government has relied on people to do much of their surveillance and that people would turn in other people, even their neighbors. Our friends shared that China now has many super computers that monitor people and financial transactions, as well as text messaging. The whole country is under surveillance!

China also has the "great firewall" and over 1 million 5G towers, which is 60% of 5G in the world. The 5G network lets them gather information in real time and it is then processed very quickly by the super computers. These computers look for signs of subversion.

China is working at separating the internet inside China from the rest of the world, and if they go to a digital currency that is backed by real money, as they plan, they will be able to know everything anyone buys.

Biometrics and facial recognition are in the cities and the airports. Our friend shared how if you J-walk, your name will be displayed on a box there warning you that they saw you and that you could get fined.

Russia, like China, has instituted many laws to keep people under surveillance. Three years ago, they passed a law that internet providers and cell phone companies were required to keep all of their client's information for a minimum of one year.

The world is changing very fast, as we can see. Believers must not fear. As Maksim says, "we must continue God's work and use every opportunity we have to share the good news of the coming Kingdom."

I am sure our Chinese brethren have the same prayer request as our Russian-speaking brethren. "Please pray for our faith to be strong and that we would be encouraged in our spirits. Pray for unity among the scattered church and that ministry, preaching, and evangelism would continue."

Maksim reminded me that even though there are problems in the world and with the economy, the most important thing is to be in the place God put us and to work and serve with all we have. This is true in Russia and in China. **Our brethren know that whether they live, or weather they die, they have resurrection hope; and we must all remain faithful wherever we live.**


