Roman had attended a Pentecostal church for a while, but found the "charismatic show" unbiblical. After studying with Maksim the couple saw he was speaking biblical truth and they accepted the simple Bible teaching we know and love.

While studying with them Maksim also addressed the issue of righteousness and godly living. Although not totally ready to commit their lives to following Jesus, after a year and a half, Roman and Katya decided to be obedient to God's teachings and get married rather than just living together. They saw the need to start making life changes if they wanted to follow Christ.


