We Say: Jesus is Not GOD!

We are people of all ages, people of many backgrounds, and people of many beliefs. We are brave, curious and compassionate thinkers and doers. We create spirituality and community beyond boundaries, working for more justice and more love in our own lives and in the world.

Most Christians have been taught that Jesus is both “fully God and fully man”; that he is God Almighty clothed in human flesh. Also, it is said that in addition to Jesus, two other individuals are also fully God: the Father, and another person called the Holy Spirit. All three of these persons, it is claimed, are co-equal; no one is greater than the other. Yet while all three are divine, they are somehow not three deities. Rather, they are said to mysteriously share the same single essence; an inexplicable “three-in-one” being.

Theologians both ancient and modern have claimed that this mysterious “Doctrine of the Trinity” is the core of the Christian faith. While churches today actually disagree on many details of this doctrine, and most admit that it is ultimately impossible to understand, it is often claimed to be necessary for salvation.

But what if Jesus himself never taught these things? What if the Bible actually teaches something completely different?

Could it be possible that the real message of the New Testament has been radically misinterpreted, and those misinterpretations have simply been passed onto the next generation? What if the claims of Jesus have been so badly misunderstood, and Church tradition so heavily influenced by ancient, pagan philosophers, that the original faith of Jesus and his disciples has gone unrecognized by many believers today? What if the “the Doctrine of the Trinity” isn’t actually Biblical after all?

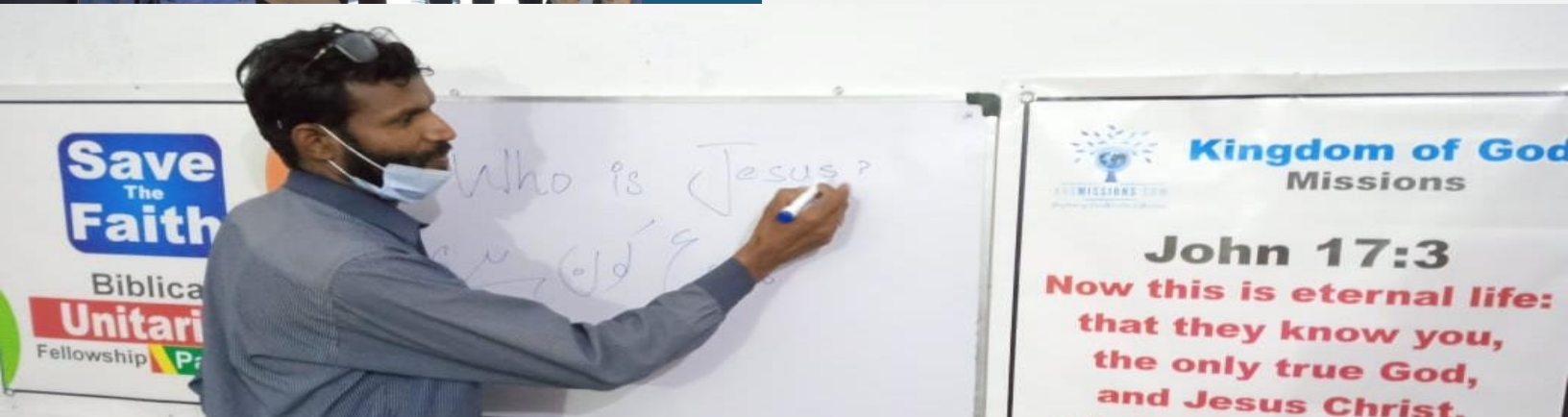
Children

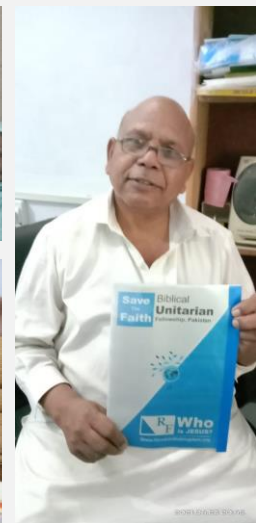
Media/Tech

Pastor of Discipleship

Time Commitment: Full Time

Director Report: Lead Pastor

Role Description:

The Pastor of Discipleship primary functions are to fulfill the role as a ministry strategist by implementing a plan to develop mature disciples; planning, implementing, and monitoring the vision as discerned and directed by the lead pastor and elders; developing key ministries, processes, and initiatives with the intention of releasing ministry to developed leaders; ensuring existing ministries are in alignment with the overall mission, vision, and values of Unitarian fellowship.

1. Develop, Implement, Maintain, and Monitor a Discipleship Process

- Develop a process that will engage visitors, attendees, and covenant members in discipleship.
- Teach classes for equipping God's people.
- Oversee the process of helping first time visitors connect with the Church and become fully mature disciples.
- Develop and monitor metrics to evaluate our effectiveness.
- Equip, train and monitor leaders for discipleship.
- Provide oversight, direction, and support for the new members at Unitarian Fellowship.
- Lead (with the Lead Pastor) the Membership Class and process.

2. Develop Small Group Ministries as Part of the Discipleship Process

- Develop and maintain a clear vision and process for small group ministry for the adults of Unitarian Fellowship.
- Call, develop, and mentor small group leaders.
- Ensure that all who are interested in being part of a small group community have access.

3. Develop and Monitor First Impressions Ministries

- Provide direction and vision for the First Impressions Ministry Team.
- Work with the leaders of all ministry teams to ensure that they are sensitive to the needs of visitors.
- Develop and implement a process to help visitors become active members who are relationally connected and using their spiritual gifts to serve the Kingdom.

4. Preaching and Worship

- Preach God's Truth in a way that challenges the people of Unitarian fellowship to transform (preaching on average one time per month).
- Participate with the Lead Pastor in the process of determining the preaching content for worship services.



5. General Responsibilities

- Attend all Elder meetings that are not in conflict with the Deacon meetings.
- Attend all staff meetings.
- Participate as a member of the Organic Outreach Team.



Requirements:

- Gives evidence of a personal and growing relationship with Jesus Christ, demonstrating the biblical qualities of 1 Timothy 3:1-7, Titus 1:5-9 and 1 Peter 5:1-5 with integrity, humility, responsibility, teachability and servanthood as a gracious and loving pastor.
- We prefer candidates who are ordained.
- Believes, accepts and supports Unitarian fellowship's vision, mission, values, and core beliefs.
- Believes, accepts and supports Reformed theology.
- Works hard and plays well with others.
