OUR HISTORY.

The work in Kenya began in early 2009 with a small group of brethren who were just coming to the knowledge of the one true God, the kingdom of God and the state of the dead till resurrection among many other truths!

Pastor Maurice Chahilu, a banker then had just made contact with Sean Finnegan on line while in search of deeper truth concerning the basic bible teachings.

Through brother Finnegan, contact was established with mum Rebekah Martin and dad Dr. Joe Martin who by that time had already established contact with a few brethren from the southern part of Kenya key among them were James Nyangute and Amos Anyanga from Kilgoris.

Correspondence continued for sometime until finally we held our first conference with the Africa mission team led by Dr. Joe Martin and Rebekah Martin in 2013, this brought together the team from the south and the north from which a team of six members who held similar convictions and were of like mind regarding the restoration of lost biblical truths as practiced by the early church was constituted to over see and advance the kingdom work in Kenya.

The church of God in Kenya was officially registered in the name of (KINGDOM LIFE ABRAHAMIC FAITH MINISTRIES) on 25th of June 2015 with its NATIONAL HEAD QUARTERS in the northern part at Maturu village near Webuye town.

This six member team was later transformed to a national executive committee (NEC) being the top governing organ of the church of God Abrahamic faith in Kenya and a part of the national board during the Africa mission team visit of 2017 where Dr. Joe officially approved it on behalf of church of God general conference (COGGC) and Lords Harvest International (L.H.I)

Bishop Maurice Chahilu of maturu is currently serving as the chairperson to the board, and is deputized by James Oigara Nyagute from kilgoris.

Pst. Doicus Sindani from mature is the treasurer to the board, secretary to the board is Pst. Richard Mogeni from Ogembo deputized by Pst. Amos Atsiali Anyanga from Kilgoris.

Pst. Aggry lumwaji and all other regional leaders form part of the national board as members.

The national board administratively oversees the churches in Kenya and acts as a link to the church of God general conference u.s.a.

OUR MINISTRY STRATEGY

The church of God in Kenya has adopted three strategies in expanding the kingdom of God.

1. We work by establishing study groups in various locations through which new churches are launched.
2. Training and equipping ministers for the work of ministry who are then sent out to fulfill their callings in line with the revealed truth.
3. We also work with like minded brethren and pastors who are already in ministry and are willing to embrace these restored truths within their local congregations in order to bring them to a common understanding of the scriptures.

OUR CHURCH ORGANISATION

The church of God Abrahamic faiths in Kenya is a non Trinitarian Christian body which is congregational in government but cooperate in missions and ministries, and is led by a bishop who assumes oversight over all church congregations, the church has so far established 17 branches country wide. Every congregation offers ministry to the following groups;

- The men ministry.
- The women ministry.
- The youth ministry.
- The teenagers and Sunday school ministry.

The church conducts annual events that bring together participants from various churches across the nation for a time of edification, fellowship and training.

We also hold THEOLOGICAL CONFERENCES in different church locations in which we address doctrinal issues.

We conduct workers seminars to equip and train our ministers and leaders in different departments.

Outreach initiatives are a common approach to preaching the gospel of the kingdom of GOD in our primary ministry areas.
