


- God created the earth & paradise for mankind.

be released for a short time. Revelation 20:1-3





= sleeping (dead) righteous (saved) person

⇒ = sleeping (dead) unrighteous (unsaved) person

Jesus' Example

- Preached, Taught & Revealed Future Kingdom Life
- Parables (Matthew 13, 18, 22 & 25)
- Talked about for 40 Days after Resurrection (Acts 1:1-3)

Resurrection – 1 Corinthians 15:12-28

- If no resurrection, then you are still in your sins
- Jesus was the first resurrected to immortality
- Saints are the next to be resurrected at Jesus' return
- Jesus must reign until all enemies are under his feet and death is destroyed
- Then, he will turn the kingdom over to his Father, God.
