
Do we care? Do we take it seriously for ourselves?

Mt. 26:37-39 Jesus began to be grieved and distressed. ³⁸ Then He *said to them, "My soul is deeply grieved, to the point of death.... "My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from Me; yet not as I will, but as You will." 26:42 He went away again a second time and prayed, saying, "My Father, if this cannot pass away unless I drink it, Your will be done."...44 went away and prayed a third time, saying the same thing once more. **JESUS SERIOUSLY DIDN'T WANT TO GO THROUGH THIS!**

Mark 15:39 Jesus, the SON of God, died. When the centurion, who was standing [s] right in front of Him, saw [t] the way He breathed His last, he said, "Truly this man was the Son of God!"


