



Jesus gave us a higher standard!




Study and know what Jesus taught – Sermon on the Mount, his interaction with his disciples

What we think/believe should reflect what Jesus taught – line up with it

How we act should reflect how Jesus acted

Can't claim to follow Jesus, but sound and act like the world



John 20:21, 17:18 Just as God sent Jesus, Jesus sends us! (and we are empowered to do this!) (Acts 1:8)

Jesus was given all authority in heaven and on earth - (Matthew 28:18) So since he has this supremacy, **what he says matters!**

Romans 10:14-17 How can people call on the name of the Lord if they do not hear? How can they hear if nobody preaches and how can someone preach if they are not sent? Sent by Jesus...

Jesus said to Go make disciples... We hear this all the time, but how do we do that?



Teach – This is the core of discipleship. **To teach we must do so with WORDS** – the words of Jesus and the words of the Bible

Teaching occurs when you learn to have spiritually meaningful conversations with people (Jesus' examples....lady at well, when children were around him, etc.) In order to do that though, you must talk about spiritual, biblical things amongst yourselves to start

Fine to talk about sports and children, but find ways to bring up sermons, Bible topics, what God's been teaching you lately... You can ask what God has been teaching them... small groups can help too. If we don't do this amongst ourselves, how can we expect to be able to or comfortable with unbelievers?!



Correct – sometimes requires you to warn others about the choices they are making.

Must fear God more than worry about what people think.

Teach truths, correct errors



Model – Jesus didn’t command to just teach people, but to teach them to OBEY.


The goal is to make disciples, not just teach. When people heard the preaching, they asked what they needed to do. (Acts 2:37-38)

We must live out the whole Christian life before others. Jesus was the ultimate model. (1 Peter 2:21)

We communicate with our words and our whole lives – People will listen, watch and participate with us

We invest, share, and pray for, not for what we might receive, other than the satisfaction and joy knowing that people are better equipped and prepared for Jesus’ coming

What Should We Be Able To Teach?



If we are going to make disciples, we need to know the information inside and out so it is second nature to speak. (Which is why we need to talk about it amongst ourselves first and ongoing!) This will also give us confidence.

Then we need to be able to share what we know. AGAIN, this comes from talking about it and discussing it amongst ourselves – often! That’s what parents are told to talk and teach about with their children throughout the day and as they travel.

It’s not difficult, but it does take time and effort.



Plant the Seed of the Kingdom
