

- Only LORD, the true God (Isa. 45:18; Jer. 10:10-13)
- Formed the earth to be inhabited (Isa. 45:18)
- Wisdom, understanding, knowledge, power, discretion (Prov. 3:19-20; Jer. 10:10-13)
- Eternal power, divine nature (Rom. 1:19-20)



And the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living being.



And the LORD God said, "It is not good that man should be alone; I will make him a helper comparable [corresponding] to him."




²¹ And the LORD God caused a deep sleep to fall on Adam, and he slept; and He took one of his ribs, and closed up the flesh in its place.


