Next we met a lady from a Skype fellowship and took the train north, near Manchester, for a weekend fellowship. Several traveled for hours just to obey the Scriptures and be baptized or re-baptized.

The last evening we flew to Prague and met with some brethren the next day from the Czech Republic and from Slovakia. I thoroughly enjoyed this meeting and it was a blessing to all. Most of the brethren had been kicked out of the church they were going to, including the pastor! That evening we took an overnight bus to Switzerland and one of the brothers from Slovakia went with us.

After spending a few days in Zurich, we traveled by overnight bus with our brother from Slovakia to Budapest to visit a young ex-JW we have been in contact with over the past year.

It was a joy to talk with him for several hours and hear how he is trying to share the good news of the kingdom and the human Messiah with those around him.

Lastly, we finally met Maksim in Belarus where we went to visit family.
