yard, like they did at their last meeting. As you can see on their faces, they had a very blessed time of fellowship! It was a refreshing and invigorating time of prayer, Bible study and discussion. Praise God for this opportunity! They were all strengthened in the truth and encouraged each other to continue walking that truth out in their daily lives.



After visiting Simon and Tatyana, Maksim traveled another two days by train to meet sisters Sophia and Valentina at Valentina's relative's house in the Far East, near Mongolia and China. After meeting together for several weeks Sophia's diabetes acted up and she lost the use of her legs. Maksim and Valentina stayed to nurse her with hope that she could return home. Unfortunately, she died. We find comfort in that she died in faith

and we will see her when Jesus returns and she is resurrected along with the other saints.



Please pray for our new brother Vitaliy. He lives near Chita in Siberia. Maksim met him about four years ago in the hospital. They stayed in touch and corresponded over that time while Vitaliy studied and grew in knowledge. After years of drinking and gambling, Vitaliy finally gave that up about 2 years ago after a bad accident. Praise God he turned to Jesus and embraced the Father's forgiveness.

Pastor Maksim took a train two and a half days (one way) to go baptize Vitaliy. They rented a small pool in a local banya and he was baptized there. Afterwards a friend came over and was interested to hear what Maksim had to share. Please pray for Vitaliy as he grows in faith and for his friend to have an open heart and mind and desire to keep in touch with Maksim.




