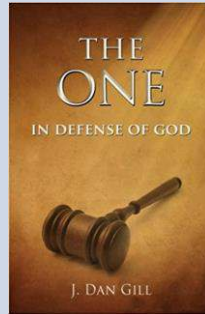

Books are an essential tool in Russian ministry.

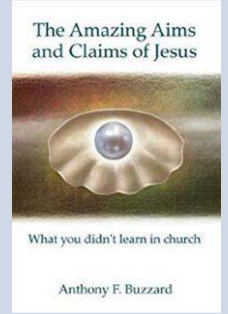
Please consider how you or your church might be able to help print these two books. Due to all of Maksim's hardships over the past year, printing has been postponed. The need is great now and we must get them printed.

END OF THE AGE?

First COVID, and now the Israel/Arab Peace Treaty have gotten many Christians talking about the end of this age and the return of Christ.

You hear comments like, “Something is coming! We must be prepared!” or “God is on the move in mighty ways.”

My questions is that IF we truly believe that God is moving things closer to the Great Tribulation and the return of Christ, then why are we not more inspired and motivated to be obedient to the last commands of Jesus, the one we claim to follow?

This gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in the whole world as a testimony to all the nations, and then the end will come. (Matthew 24:14)

All authority has been given to me (Jesus) in heaven and on

earth. Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the holy spirit, teaching them to observe all that I commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age. (Matthew 28:18-20)

These two passages could not be clearer expectations as to what Jesus requires from his followers.

The nations must have the opportunity to hear the Kingdom message. This Gospel and all that it entails is our responsibility to preach, teach, post, tweet, and make known in any other way that we have available to us.

If you are a Christian, you have a responsibility. You have two options, preach, teach, and disciple people, or, support and pray for those who are doing this. We are a team and we must be faithful to our Master, especially since we have the blessed assurance of the first resurrection and immortality.

If we believe end time events are mounting and Jesus’ return is soon, our activity of proclaiming the Gospel of the Kingdom should be increasing. Our concern should not be for ourselves because we have the hope of resurrection! **Our concern must be for those who have not had the opportunity to hear and accept the call of Jesus to follow him and his teachings.**

Will we obey and actually *follow* him who called us?

Did you know that the words *missionary* & *missions* are not found in the writings of the New Testament? There is not a “gift” of being a “missionary.” But, we are all called to be one.

The definition of a missionary is, “a person undertaking a mission.” Jesus gave us all a mission (“a specific task with which a person or a group is charged”), and all Christians must work to fulfill it! (merriam-webster.com)

Jesus commissioned us to go and proclaim to the nations that God’s righteous government will be over all the countries on Earth. We should be making disciples and Kingdom citizens and preparing them to take part in the inauguration ceremony of Jesus, God’s King.
