## **Last 7 Years Before Jesus' Return**

(Daniel 12:7) It is for a time, times, and half a time. Then, when the power of the one who shatters the holy people has been exhausted, all these things will be finished.

(Daniel 9:27) He will confirm a <u>covenant</u> with many for <u>one week</u>. But <u>in the middle of that week, he will bring sacrifices and offerings to a halt</u>. On the wing of abominations will come one who destroys.

**Treaty/Covenant for 7 years** 

**Luke 21:20** "when you see Jerusalem surrounded by armies, then know that its desolation has come near"

**Matthew 24: 15** "When you see the abomination of desolation—spoken about by Daniel the prophet—standing in the holy place" (let the reader understand)"

**Daniel 11:31** His forces will rise up and profane the fortified sanctuary, stopping the daily sacrifice. *In its place* they will set up the abomination that causes desolation."

## Great Suffering, Great Distress, GREAT TRIBULATION

From the time that the daily sacrifice is removed and the abomination that causes desolation is set in place, there are 1,290 days. (Daniel 12:11)

Blessed is the one who waits and attains to the 1,335 days. (Daniel 12:12)

Abomination of Desolation (AoD)

Outer courtyard gentiles trample for 42 months, <u>2 witnesses</u> given authority to prophesy for **1,260 days**, dressed in sackcloth. (Revelation 11:3)

Revelation 12:6,14 (woman) she fled into the wilderness where a place had been prepared for her by God, so she could be taken care of for 1,260 days. She is taken care of—away from the presence of the serpent—for a time, times, and half a time.

Man of Lawlessness - 2 Thessalonians 2:3-4 "He opposes and exalts himself above every so-called god or object of worship, and as a result he takes his seat in God's temple, displaying himself as God."

**Beast - Revelation 13:3, 5** "lethal wound had been healed, the beast was given a mouth speaking proud words and blasphemies, and he was permitted to exercise ruling authority for **forty-two months** 

King of the North/ despicable person - Daniel <u>11</u>:21, 36-39 "the king will do as he pleases. He will exalt and magnify himself above every deity and he will utter presumptuous things against the God of gods."

The Anti-Christ – 1 John 2:18 "you heard that the antichrist is coming, so now many antichrists have appeared"
