The Pakistan school year will be starting in January and the children once again need workbooks and books. Sarah has taken over Maryam's senior teaching role since Maryam went to the UK for work. The pastors also help in the classroom as they can.

There are about 40 students that are put into two different classes due to space. They need approximately \$130 for each child's schoolbooks. We still need to fund about 21 students. Please consider what you or your church can do.

This school gives an education to children who cannot afford to go to school, and to many girls who would never get an education or learn to read. Many learn the Bible as well.

Please continue to pray for the pastors and evangelism team. They are working hard and adjusting to Haroon and Mayam being in the UK. Haroon continues to work with the pastors and leaders and support them spiritually.

I have had people ask about how I make videos and how long it takes. Great question! It can be a day or two, or several weeks.

It really depends on the video, but they all start with a script (research, if necessary, like with the Jehovah's Witness ones) and then finding or creating images or video clips (which take a considerable amount of time!)

If I am doing a *Bible Chalk Talk* video, creation starts with the above program creating the scenes. I have several other programs I can create different animation as well, depending on the video.

When that is finished, I bring it into my video editor (below) and upload other graphics and overlays (more time searching or creating), and add other text if necessary while editing the video.



I also add an intro that I created in another program, and lastly, I add voiceover, music, and sound effects.

After I save it and upload to YouTube. I then create a thumbnail for YouTube and write the description, key words, and other info before publishing it live.

If it is not an animated one, like the *Simple Bible Truth* videos, then I shoot the video, edit it, add any text or graphics and finish as above. Often the videos have both live and animated features. I enjoy it, and God seems to be using them to bless others, praise the Lord!
