CHRISTIAN PERSECUTION

Now in fact all who want to live godly lives in Christ Jesus will be persecuted. (2 Timothy 3:12) Remember what I told you, 'A slave is not greater than his master.' If they persecuted me, they will also persecute you. (John 15:20) They will hand you over to be persecuted and will kill you. You will be hated by all the nations because of my name. (Matthew 24:9)

Matthew 5 tells us that we are blessed and that the Kingdom will belong to us if we are persecuted for righteousness. We should consider ourselves blessed when people insult us, persecute us, and falsely say all kinds of evil about us. Jesus told us this would happen and he told us to rejoice and be glad because our reward will be great!

Do we embrace this persecution or do all we can to avoid it? Are we more concerned about preserving our mortal lives today, or living in obedience and hope of resurrection and immortality in the coming age?
