Sacrificial Pastoral Care

Maksim is not only an evangelist, a missionary, and a minister of Jesus' Gospel of the Kingdom, but he is a compassionate pastor of the Russian-speaking flock scattered around Russia and in many other countries in the region. It isn't about numbers; he deeply cares for each sheep in his fold and goes above and beyond for even one brother thousands of miles away.

I was amazed early on at such a young man who fervently cared for dear brother Uli as he was dying with a brain tumor. Maksim, only in his 20's, cared tenderly for him throughout his decline and intense pain, even caring for his disabled daughter and mother-in-law at the same time. My heart was deeply touched.

This past month Maksim made another cross-country trip to help another brother who had a terrible accident and had no family able to help him. He traveled nearly 3 days by train and then spent several days helping get brother Igor's paperwork together so he would be able to receive disability. He then rented an ambulance to take him 18 hours to an elderly aunt and uncle where he would now live.

He then spent a week helping him get settled and the paperwork there in place. Maksim was able to buy him a wheelchair so he could get around the apartment. Lord willing in a couple months he will get one from the government for outside use. Unfortunately, Russia is not disability friendly and Igor will probably be spending most of his life in the apartment now. Please pray for him as he gets accustomed to his new life with only one leg. Psychologically it has been very hard for him. Pray that he would find new purpose and that his faith would remain strong. He is only 39.

When they arrived, the elderly aunt cried with gratitude that Maksim was able to help Igor; and when Maksim left, Igor cried and thanked him profusely for his help and for the help of the brethren who made the trip possible and who were fervently praying for him. Maksim then

traveled 4 days by train back home.

This unexpected trip came only 3 days after he returned home after traveling weeks to baptize two new sisters.

Maksim continues to talk to Igor several times a week and encourage him in the faith. They were able to study together and spent much time in prayer when Maksim was with him.

Maksim will be 35 in July and is very grateful to serve God and the brethren while he has strength and health. (He began serving when he was 24 and is a great testimony and example for young people desiring to follow Christ and serve in ministry.)

Maksim is an inspiration to me and his self-sacrificing faithfulness encourages me to strive even more to give all of myself to ministry and to the brethren I have been blessed to serve.

Next month will be the 10-year anniversary of our ministry partnership. We rejoice in this blessing and pray for God's strength and continued opportunities.

For just as the body without the spirit is dead, so also faith without works is dead. (James 2:14-26)

We will be saved by our faith and works, that is by living faithfully trusting our Lord and walking in obedience to him.

For by grace you are saved through faith, and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God; it is not from works, so that no one can boast. (The works in and of themselves, do not save, but in obedience and out of love we obey and do good works for our Father's glory.)

For we are his creative work, having been created in Christ Jesus for good works that God prepared beforehand so we can do them. (Ephesians 2:8-10)

We must not bury the what has been given to us, starting with the saving Gospel of the Kingdom.

Salvation requires our belief and works, but in and of themselves they do not save. It is God's grace through our faith and works that we will receive our inheritance, along with Abraham (Hebrews 11:39-40). Maranatha!




