2 More Baptisms in Russia



Pastor Maksim is on the rails again going to baptize a new brother and sister into the faith of Jesus.

Maksim met Nelly (59) in the hospital 3-4 years ago. He visited her once when he was traveling to visit brethren and he also met her son Ilya (36). He said Ilya was a bit hostile toward him thinking he was with a cult group and wanting to scam his mother. But a year and a half ago he began reading the literature and conversing with Maksim. He has now repented and they both wanted to be baptized. (*Books & written material is SO important!*)

Ilya moved in with his mother to care for her when she became bedridden and lives with her as her caregiver.

Maksim will be traveling by train 24 hours to Krasnoyarsk where he will take another train or bus 7-8 hours to their town. Afterwards he will go back to Krasnoyarsk and fly to visit brother Oleg. Upon returning to Krasnoyarsk, he will then take the 24-hour train home.

Do we take this seriously in our lives, homes, churches, and ministries? When we teach and minister, we are presenting ourselves and our teachings before God. Can we step back and seriously say that we are not ashamed of what we have done or *not* done?

When reflecting on our lives and ministries, can we say with a resounding YES, that we are teaching Jesus' message of truth accurately? Or do we leave some of it out?

I solemnly charge you before God and Christ Jesus, who is going to judge the living and the dead, and by his appearing and his kingdom: Preach the message, be ready whether it is convenient or not, reprove, rebuke, exhort with complete patience and instruction. For there will be a time when people will not tolerate sound teaching. Instead, following their own desires, they will accumulate teachers for themselves, because they have an insatiable curiosity to hear new things. And they will turn away from hearing the truth. (2 Timothy 4:1-4)

As Paul charged Timothy before God and Jesus, how much more do they charge us, especially those teaching and preaching, whether in a formal ministry or not, to preach the message, be ready whether it is convenient or not, reprove, rebuke, exhort with complete patience and instruction?

Do we do that? Or <u>do we fall back when it is not</u> convenient?

Are we one of the many who do not tolerate sound teaching?
