

God" believers and ministries, and some U.S. pastors are preaching at their services online. We have also been invited to "partner" with them, but we cannot in good conscience support ministries that preach bondage and have no desire to change those beliefs.

We must preach biblical truth and not compromise just to feel we are "expanding" our ministries. We must remember that "our" ministries are not ours. We have been called to participate with like-minded brethren in spreading the faith of Jesus to the nations. We must take Jesus' great commission to his followers seriously and teach what he taught and teach people to OBEY everything he taught.

I have had lengthy exchanges with some of the leaders of these Sabbath, Mosaic Law-keeping ministers, and they are proclaiming another Gospel. It took many exchanges, asking them over and over again if they practiced the Mosaic Law and kept the feasts. They did not want to tell the truth the first time I asked.

One of the men I wrote with said, "I am not saying that you should start calling yourself Jews. You are one of those who believe in Christ and will be called a Christian (whether you are a Messianic Jew like me or an empty Christian)."

These men have tried to get Pastor Haroon & Maryam (Save the Faith) to join them, but they told them they could not because of their views and practices.

If one chooses to preach at their services a good place to start would be addressing this vital issue about the New Covenant that Jesus and the Apostles proclaimed.

We should not "partner" with false teachers and no money should be given to people preaching other gospels because that binds us to their message. What would Jesus do?

# We are the True Minority

Jesus said in Matthew 7:14 that the gate is narrow and the way difficult that leads to life, and there are few who find it!

Christianity, that is those who follow Jesus and hold to HIS faith, is not growing with leaps and bounds as many Evangelicals proclaim. Those truly following the human Messiah, Jesus, and those proclaiming his message of the coming Kingdom are few. We are the minority!

But better to be in the minority, one of the faithful few who stay on Jesus' narrow path, than to be one of the many who are on the wide road to destruction.

Will you stand with Jesus and embrace his faith, or will you deny him before men. Will you compromise the faith of Jesus and what he preached for the sake of a bigger church, "better" music, or larger youth groups? (None of those later things save, and in fact, if you think you are helping your children by giving them "more," you are often actually teaching them to deny Christ and his teachings for the sake of the world and your personal desires.)

Jesus told his followers to follow him on the NARROW path. Following Jesus just in name is not following Jesus.

**Jesus demands total allegiance.** We cannot claim to follow him and at the same time sit in a church or support a ministry that not only does not preach and teach what

Jesus did, but proclaims false, unbiblical teachings and doctrines of demons.

Are we willing to lay down our desires and perceived needs in order to actually follow Jesus? Or do we get caught up in the institution of "church" and seek and follow the bells and whistles?

I have seen many professing Christians boldly professing their political views and even getting on the activist wagon, rather than professing what Jesus told his followers to preach and teach. And often, the activism they pursue is not only condemned as sin in the Bible, but said to be detestable to God. What would Jesus do? Would he give a thumbs up "like" to the post?

Being on the narrow path is not just about morality, but also about faith - what we believe and profess. Brothers and sisters, we are the minority on the narrow path and we must remain faithful to Jesus and his message that God gave him. We must strive to walk in obedience to all that he taught, and we must be faithful in proclaiming his Kingdom Gospel. And remember, Jesus said few accept it!

Are we willing to stand united and unapologetically proclaim the faith of Jesus and the coming Kingdom of God, or will our voices be silenced by political activism, desire for numbers, and other gospels?

Misunderstanding that the Kingdom is future and that we are eagerly awaiting the Lord Jesus' coming can lead to discouragement, a feeling of a failed hope because we do not see the effects that his coming will have in this present time. That's the risk. Hope deferred makes the heart sick. When we know it is still future, we can look forward with faith, knowing that our salvation is at hand. 
