

The new year will start with a ministry trip to Pakistan and the UK. There will be two conferences in Pakistan and other teaching opportunities.

In the UK there will be several places of fellowship, several days in Dorchester, and then in London.

The brothers in Pakistan went on several evangelism trips and took the messages, who Jesus is and what happens when die, to other villages and cities and shared these Bible truths with who would listen.

I am very grateful for the different fellowship opportunities we have had throughout this past year. I am thankful for the weekly online Bible studies and for the fellowship. We were blessed at the *Gospel Gathering* in Atlanta, and a sisters gathering in Minnesota. It was also a blessing to share in several baptisms when we were in Atlanta.

We had a successful 8th Annual Missions Conference and I am very grateful for all of the presenters and for those who joined us live for those three days!

God has continued to grow the video ministry and Lord willing in January Kingdom of God Ministry & Missions YouTube channel will hit 1000 videos.

May God continue to bless our sacrifices and efforts in the coming year! And may God bless *you* richly as you bless the saints and take the Gospel of the Kingdom to the nations.

There are many irreconcilable absurdities in the idea of incarnation. If God incarnates in an infant, then either his previous divine form dies and life begins anew as a human being (which is impossible because God does not die), or the old form does not die, and then Christ is not fully human, but still God (as Trinitarians believe), which makes His humanity clearly subordinate to His divine nature. A man of flesh, whose will, emotions, abilities, and attributes are both human and divine. Can such a being still be called a human being? Jesus' life and mission prove that there was no divine nature in Him: first, He died; second, He was exalted by God (to what could He be exalted, having already been God?); third, It is God who authenticates Him, not Himself (Acts 2:22).
