Pakistan Ministry Trip 2026



The second day was the women's conference. Where both conferences were held was about 30-40 minutes from the hotel, with no traffic. There was never a day with no traffic.

We started in the room but due to how many were coming, we moved to the roof. There were both women and children present. In both the men's and the women's conferences, there were biblical unitarian believers and trinitarians as well. After sharing our messages, we had some good individual questions about baptism and one boy wanted to know more about hell and punishment. Many also asked for prayer, which was a great teaching moment as well.

The third day was the men's conference, personally my most enjoyable day being that I love preaching and teaching to an engaged audience. We had a very good Q&A after Merryl and I spoke. I thoroughly enjoyed the challenging questions, the discussion, and how they received biblical truth, especially from 2 women. They were respectful and grateful for our solid biblical responses on a variety of topics.

At both conferences Merryl spoke about the 8 Kingdom Texts in Acts, and I gave a full gospel presentation following Jesus' command to go and teach people to obey everything that he commanded.

Merryl & I left Minnesota early Tuesday Morning and arrived in Islamabad on Wednesday at about 6 pm local time. We were warmly welcomed by Haroon, Maryam, and their lovely children.

For security reasons and Haroon's peace of mind, they stayed at the hotel with us. The two younger children were with us all the time, as you will see in the videos (*links on page 3*). The children were patient and well-behaved, and they, too, understand that ministry is what is most most important. With that said, they are not neglected and, in fact, are loved very much and they were blessed several times for their patience! I also appreciated my son greatly, as did all those we met, for taking care of the farm while I was gone.

The first day was an "easy" day after our long travels. We went to a market and then visited pastor Rafi in his home and met his family. Then we had dinner at Maryam's parents' house and met her family and Haroon's sister.

Day 4 was Sunday and we went to a church that pastor Pervez was asked to speak at when he could come. The lead man there had a commercial school and after finding the one God and human messiah himself in Scripture, he had a small church gathering meeting in one of the school rooms.

Haroon had not met Fabian before, but in conversation he learned that he had some unbiblical ideas about Scripture. They spoke a long time and the man reached out to Haroon after and said that he would like to learn more from him. Please pray for Haroon as he continues to disciple him, and for the pastors who will also be working with him, as long as he is open to letting go of false ideas and wants to know biblical truth.

Afterwards we went to Taxilla to see the ruins at Sirkap where the apostle Thomas was said to have preached. They said that many people come there and do videos, so they asked me to do one as well. Then we went to a dam where we had lunch at an outdoor café and then went to see where Pastor Pervez lives and met his family.

On Monday, day 5, we went to the school and spent the day with the children as they did their lessons. After the lessons we were able to give them the coats and toys and other things for the classroom, which included a computer, that were so generously donated. At the end we had a little party with them. This ministry gives children who would otherwise be unable to attend school the opportunity to learn to read and write. In the evening we went to a catholic man's house for dinner, with whom Haroon has been engaging in discussion for years. Asher had many questions and wanted to hear how we would answer. This was another encouraging part of our time there.

Day 6, the last full day in Pakistan we had a team meeting at the office and discussed the ministry moving forward and the importance of preaching and teaching all the teachings of Jesus and the coming Kingdom that was at the forefront of his ministry. The electricity went out once again, as it often does, so we continued in candlelight. The brothers are eager to continue learning and to take the teachings of Jesus to those who will listen. We encouraged them that even though they are few in number, it is important to strengthen those few in biblical truth. We reminded them that this is the same all over the world!

That evening we took the pastors, evangelist, and school teacher, out for dinner. It was a nice ending to a successful and blessed ministry trip.

We left the next morning to go on the next leg of our trip, which was to visit and encourage the brethren in the UK before heading home to Oregon and Minnesota.
