Thank you for your prayers for Maksim's long journey this July. The brothers were very grateful to the sisters who donated for an airline ticket so Maksim could come see them too. Maksim was very grateful for the airline ticket because the weather was hot and muggy and more days on the train would have been miserable!

As planned, Maksim left July 4th and took the overnight train to Novosibirsk and spent time with elderly brother Arkadi. On the 7th he flew 5 1/2 hours to Vladivostok. Arriving late night, he went to the bus station to wait for the afternoon bus to get to where sister Claudia lived. Five more hours on a bus, and he finally arrived. He spent ten days with her and baptized Claudia at a local banya. They had a blessed time of fellowship and study, and he was also able to share more about the faith with her relatives that she lived with.



Maksim also met with a couple in their 50's that he had been corresponding with. They were former 7th Day Adventists.

On the 19th, Maksim took a bus 13 hours to Khabarovsk where he met with Nikolai and Vitali. They said that they were so grateful to the sisters who made it possible for him to visit them and were very thankful for everybody's prayers. They both have bad health issues but said that they do not worry about death because they have the hope of

waking up when Jesus returns.

Maksim encouraged them in the faith, and they studied and prayed together. Nikolai, who came to the faith after reading Anthony Buzzard's books while in prison, reminisced with Maksim about how hard it had been to quit smoking after he repented. He said that it was only with God's help and prayer that he quit.

Maksim also met with an elderly man he had been in contact with, as well as a young couple who were former Jehovah's Witnesses.

Maksim then flew back to Novosibirsk on July 28th. The 5 hour flight was much better than nearly 5 days on a train! He spent several days with sister Natalia and met with another elderly man that he had been corresponding with.

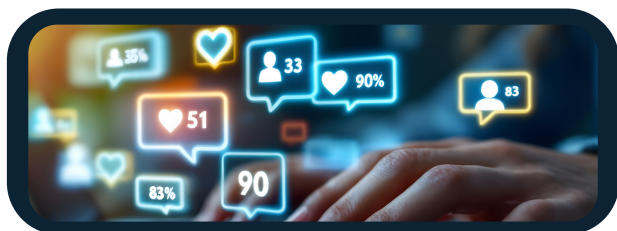


Maksim traveled approximately 6700 miles on trains, planes, and buses.
