Kody went on to say that if he was in a disabled submarine at the bottom of the ocean he would definitely find himself praying to the God he learned about at Sunday School. I asked him which church that was, but he wasn't sure...maybe Lutheran, or Anglican... but definitely not JW's, oh no, not the JW's, he had relatives there and they shunned their daughter... I smiled and

went on to change the subject. "So Kody, let's say you are in that submarine right now...."

He turned, looked at me, and said, "Okay, yes, I need to seriously consider some things. Someone told me when I die all my memories die too. I need to know what's going on. I do think that if I tend toward any religion it would be the Christian sort though."

I chatted a little about why Ray and I left the church and that we started reading everything in red. I mentioned about why Jesus came to bring us the Good News about the Kingdom. He was really keen about reading the NT so I wrote it down for him, and asked him to maybe reach out when he found the chapter in Revelation that speaks about the 1000 years of restoration. He was really keen on that bit!

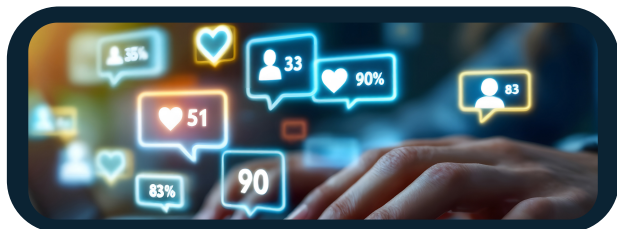
As he left, he said, "So, I start in Matthew then?" "Yep, that's where you can start!"

I hope this simple every day story and the other ways the sisters minister to those around them, will inspire you to pray for opportunities for yourself.
